**Financial**

- Dream, build play experience Peg Chaidez came to speak to LSC and parents with several examples of playground designs. Costs vary from 45,000-250,000 depending on the size and equipment we choose. They have submitted to Board of Education for approval. Julio suggested forming a committee of parents and faculty to work on this once approval goes through.
