Moving funds for after school programs for 5th and 6th Math.

Early childhood -(\$1,400 goes to miscellaneous funds) because parents workers cannot be certified. Mr. Garcia advised Mr. L to follow up with Early childhood to see if their were any restrictions.

Non-instructional funding pays for certified teachers only.

Mr. Garcia (LSC facilitator) asked about concerns asked by the Board.

Mrs. Cruz referring to the email sent by Mrs Rocco about the breakdown of the Budget transfers made to Disney program. Mrs Cruz asked if it was just teachers getting paid by funds. Mr. L explained that only certified teachers can get paid by funds. Parents involved in the Disney program are being paid by Aspira. Mr. Garcia asked about concerns asked by the board about former LSC members working at school.

Mr. Garcia explained that parent mentors can work at a school when they are hired by a Third Party Vendor. However, they may not work at the same school they served on the LSC. Former LSC members must wait a year to serve at same school. A former LSC member can work at a school as long as they are hired by a Third Party.
